Description

Performance artist is reading Kalevala, one of the most significant works of Finnish literature. (From Wikipedia - The Kalevala played an instrumental role in the development of the Finnish national identity, the intensification of Finland's language strife and the growing sense of nationality that ultimately led to Finland's independence from Russia in 1917).
